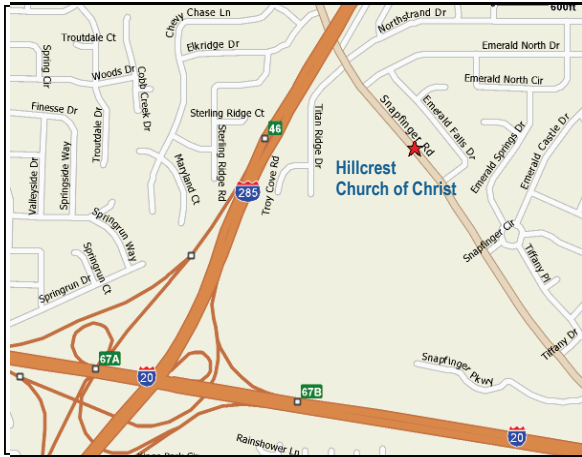


Directions



From South

- ▶ I-75, I-85, I-675 North
- ▶ Merge onto I-285 E
- ▶ Merge onto I-20 E/GA-402 E, EXIT 46B toward Augusta
- ▶ Take the Wesley Chapel Road exit—Exit 68 toward Snapfinger Rd (0.1 miles)
- ▶ Turn Left onto Wesley Chapel Road (0.3)
- ▶ Turn Left onto Snapfinger Woods Dr. (0.5)
- ▶ Turn right onto Snapfinger Rd (0.5)

From Downtown and West

- ▶ Take I-20 East towards Augusta
- ▶ (Follow Directions from South at I-20)

From East

- ▶ I-20 to Exit 68, Wesley Chapel Road
- ▶ Turn Right onto Wesley Chapel Road
- ▶ Turn Left onto Snapfinger Woods Dr. (0.5)
- ▶ Turn right onto Snapfinger Rd (0.5)

From North

- ▶ I-285 South
- ▶ Take the Glenwood Road exit—Exit 44 (0.2)
- ▶ Turn Right onto Glenwood Rd/GA-260 (0.1)
- ▶ Turn left onto Austin Dr. (0.6)
- ▶ Austin Dr becomes Snapfinger Rd

▶ **ALL- End at 1939 Snapfinger Road, Decatur**

is proud to be a host site for Angel Food Ministries (AFM). Hillcrest joined the AFM family in April, 2007 to expand our benevolence ministry and assist families with grocery relief. Hillcrest operates Feeding Hands/Feeding Hearts Food Pantry to help with hunger relief in our community. Any AFM food that is not picked up at the designated time is donated to the pantry.

As a host site, Hillcrest looks forward to an opportunity to meet new people and share the Word of God through tracks that we distribute in each box, and through an invitation to worship at "The Crest"!

Angel Food Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational organization dedicated to providing grocery relief and financial support to communities throughout the US. The program began in 1994 with 34 families in Monroe, GA and has grown to serve hundreds of thousands of families every month across 32 states. In 2006, over 500,000 families were fed through AFM. Most importantly, the good news of the gospel of Christ reached all of the families that ordered boxes of food!

Blessings by the box . . .

Angel Food's groceries are sold in a quantity that can fit into a medium-sized box at \$25 per unit. Each month's menu is different than the previous month and consists of both fresh and frozen items with an average retail value of about \$60. Comparison shopping has been done across the country using a wide range of retail grocery stores and has resulted in the same food items costing from between \$42 and \$78.

Generally, one unit of food assists in feeding a family of four for about one week or a single senior citizen for almost a month. The food is all the same high quality one would purchase at a grocery store. There are no second-hand items, no damaged or out-dated goods, no dented cans without labels, no day-old breads and no produce that is almost too ripe.

Also AFM offers specialty boxes such as steaks, chicken and pork. There is no limit to the number of units or bonus foods you can purchase, and there are no applications to complete or qualifications to which participants must adhere. **AFM also participates in the U.S. Food Stamp program**, using the Off-Line Food Stamp Voucher system.

Feeding Hands/Feeding Hearts Food Pantry

FHFH distributes non-perishable food items and hygiene products to those who have need. We serve anyone 18 years of age or older regardless of race, gender or religious affiliation. Individuals may visit the pantry once per month to receive assistance.

FHFH ministry recognizes that hunger may be only part of the need. Therefore we connect people with other resources within the community who may offer further assistance.
